Re: "Canada Park" and Tax-Deductible Dollars

I wrote on Dec. 16, 1984 to the Honourable Mr. Perrin Beatty, the then Minister of Revenue expressing concern that Canadian tax-deductible dollars are being used in an illegal act and in violation of international law. My concern was supported by the Honourable Mr. R.A. Corbett, M.P., amongst others. I was informed by Mr. Beatty that the matter is under further investigation. I wrote again on Feb. 15, 1986 to the Honourable Elmer MacKay, the then Minister of Revenue Canada, requesting to know the outcome of this investigation. I was informed by the office of the Minister of National Revenue on Feb. 28, 1986 that the matter is being reviewed and I will be provided with a reply as soon as possible. (copies of correspondence enclosed) To this date, I have had no reply.

I am writing again to request to know if this investigation has been completed and what was the outcome. It is my fervent belief that the continuing association of Canada's name with this infamy does nothing but discredit our country's good name.
